THE UNITE PROGRAM ...

In August 2016, Air Force Chief of Staff (CSAF) General David Goldfein, released his letter to Airmen titled, "The Beating Heart of the Air Force...Squadrons!"

"In Turn," AFSVC established an activity rich program that will equip Squadron/Unit Commanders with options to facilitate unit cohesion.

All <u>Air Force</u> Active duty, Reservist, <u>Guard members</u>, APF, and NAF civilians assigned to a Joint Base Andrews Unit are eligible to utilize Unite program funding.

FUNDING & ALLOCATIONS...

Per person funding is calculated from your squadron end strength and includes every Airmen (to include GS/NAF civilians).

PROGRAM/ACTIVITY FUNDS (APF)

\$13.50/per person assigned

Designated to offset or cover Airmen participation cost and supplies of the recreational / unit cohesive activity

FOOD & BEVERAGE FUNDS (NAF)

\$5.00 / per person assigned

MUST be in conjunction with an approved APF event/program

PROGRAM CANNOT BE CENTERED AROUND FOOD. There must be a recreational or interactive team-building activity that is the focus. <u>Unite IS NOT a food and beverage program.</u>

ALL purchases MUST be able to be made by Credit Card

Contractors are ineligible to receive funding – BUT CAN STILL PARTICIPATE.

Spouses and Dependents are NOW AUTHORIZED to receive funding but are NOT counted in your manning numbers



APF CAN ALSO PAY FOR ...

- X Paper Plates
- X Cups
- X Utensils
- X Napkins
- X Charcoal/Propane

- X Decorations
 X NO more than 10% of Budget
- X Foil, Foil Pans
- X Room Fees
- X Pavilion/Equipment Rental tents/tables/chairs

IF YOU CAN, RENT IT - IT WON'T BE APPROVED FOR PURCHASE



UNITE FUNDS CANNOT BE USED FOR ...

- X HOLIDAY PARTIES (End of Year EVENTS)
- X Events with no Unit-Cohesion
- X Alcohol or Gambling (INCLUDES BINGO)
- X COMBAT DINING IN/OUT
- X Change of Commands/Meet & Greets
- X Squadron Training/Meetings
- X PROMOTIONS/RETIREMENTS
- X SUPPLIES FOR VOLUNTEER EVENTS
- X Rentals of Portable Johns, Trash/Cleaning Services, Lodging, Transportation

- **X** Equipment Purchases
- X Prizes, Giveaways, Awards, PROMOTIONAL ITEMS
- X Damages or Late Fees, Taxes, Tips, or Gratuities, AND/OR INSURANCE
- X PPE Gloves, sanitizer, cleaning supplies, masks
- X NON-INCLUSIVE EVENTS
- X NO MANDATED GROUP OR WING-WIDE EVENTS

What is Considered an Unite Event...

Unite events MUST be cohesive in nature, reflected in the following type of activities

- X Recreational activities (e.g. bowling, axe throwing, sporting events, tournaments, ODR trips, etc..)
- X Fitness activities (e.g. 5k run, disc golf, dodgeball tournament, hiking, mud/ruck runs, ect.)
- X Learning of new skill or participating in an activity together (e.g. paint and sip, crafts, pottery, etc.)
- X Interactive team-building activities (e.g. scavenger hunts, EO or MFRC led activities, etc.)
- X Volunteering as a group



Unite POC Responsibilities...

- X Plan, promote and execute events that contribute to unit- cohesion and ensure maximum participation
 - X Call Vendors for pricing / request & submit quotes
 - X Reservations / contracts / RSVPs / follow-ups
- $oldsymbol{\mathsf{X}}$ Complete and submit the EVENT PROPOSAL form with CC signature
- X Schedule and attend shopping trips with C3 (if applicable) You do the shopping, I come to pay
- X Capture MINIMUM 3 event photos, to include group photo.
- X Complete and submit After Action Report (AAR) NLT $\underline{\mathsf{3}}$ business days post event

PLAN AHEAD - 10 day deadline to submit request form; atleast 1 week FROM DEPOSIT DUE DATE



C3 RESPONSIBILITIES...

- X Primary function is to serve as Unite POC's focal point for planning, development and coordination of Unite programs/events
- X Provide formal training and act as liaison for Unite POCs to oversee program execution and adherence to budget
- X Organization and distribution of funds to eligible squadrons
- X Provide "Brainstorming" one-on-one sessions with POCs and assist with ideas
- X Coordinate all submissions from beginning to end with Air Force Services Center
- X Execute all purchases in support of Unite events



THE PROCESS.....

1. Submit event proposal

Lean on your C3 for help developing your program. All event proposals must be signed by your SQ CC and will be submitted for approval to the Air Force Services Center on your behalf. Proposals must be submitted at least 21 days prior to your event.

2. Your C3 will make payments for You

Event must be approved by AFSVC before any funds are spent. If your event requires supplies or groceries, schedule a time to shop with your C3 or submit invoices for payment.


3. Host YOUR event and have fun

4. Turn in After Action Report

A few event photos and the AAR are due within 3 business days after your event. Other flight/squadron even will not be approved without previous events receipts.



EVENT SUBMISSION PROCESS



Important:

ALL BOXES MUST BE FILLED OUT
BE VERY SPECIFIC IN YOUR DESCRIPTION
INCLUDE FOOD PLAN & ANY FEES PARTICIPANTS ARE PAYING
BREAK DOWN THE FUNDING – TOTAL IT ALL UP
CC MUST AUTHORIZE DEPENDENT PARTICIPATION

Example:

ODR - \$200

Tables, Chairs, Corn Hole, Sumo Suits, Coolers, Charcoal Grill

Game Time - \$525

Mobile Game Truck, Mobile Laser Tag

Elite - \$650

Rock Wall (labor, delivery, setup) \$200 + \$525 +\$650 = \$1375 / 100 participants = \$13.75/per person



YOUR COMMANDER'S SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED ALLOW MINIMUM OF 10 Days FOR FINAL APPROVAL

----> Remember this is NOT a local approval
