

## HOW IT WORKS

Log your time spent reading using the Beanstack app or [andrewsbase.beanstack.org](https://andrewsbase.beanstack.org). For every 150 minutes logged after reading, you earn a reward -- a virtual certificate for reading 150, 450, 750, and 1000 minutes; and an in-person reward for reading 300, 600, and 900 minutes.

At the end of the Summer Reading Program, the top (4) readers, one from each age category (pre-reader, children, teen, and adult) will earn either a Tonie player (pre-reader prize) or a Kindle (children, teen, and adult prize) that will be awarded at the Summer Reading Program Closing Program on 17 Aug from 1000-1200.

Additionally, throughout the Summer Reading Program, earn a raffle ticket for each event you attend, either virtually or in person. At the end of the Summer Reading Program, one person from each age category will be randomly selected for a prize. The more events you attend and complete, the greater your chances to win!

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Only participants leaving the area before the end of the program may claim earned prizes prior to their scheduled award dates.
- The library reserves the right to substitute prizes as needed.
- Parents may register their children in the age group they feel is appropriate for them. Teens age 13 years and older may self-register.
- Upon request, library staff is happy to accommodate all participants with disabilities.
- Library Staff reserve the right to review logging in order to determine top reader prize winners
- Potential winners must not have won the prize in the past two (2) years.
- Library Staff are ineligible to receive the top reader prize.
